Deep underneath the graveyard is a medieval burial ground for plague victims, which was covered by the graveyard we see today. Might this older burial ground be the reason for so many mysterious events?

In Greyfriars Kirkyard, there is a large black mausoleum. People claim that about 20 years ago, a homeless man who was looking for somewhere to sleep broke into the mausoleum. Some say that, at that moment, a big hole opened up in the mausoleum's floor.

Since then, there has been more and more paranormal activity. Ghosts of medieval plague victims may be returning to Edinburgh. What do they want? What do they do to visitors to Greyfriars Kirkyard? Are you tempted to find out?
