**THE SUMMER OLYMPIC GAMES**

The Summer Olympics are one of the biggest sports events in the world and they are held only once every four years. More than ten thousand athletes from around the world come to the Games and millions of people watch the event on television. **1. \_\_\_\_** They have grown and changed a lot since then and many Olympic traditions have been established. The Olympics have their own anthem and their own flag. Also, on each occasion a mascot (an animal or object) is specially chosen by the host country to be the symbol of that year's Games. **2. \_\_\_\_** For the 2000 Olympics in Sydney, the mascots were three Australian animals, and in 1980 in Moscow it was a Russian bear called Misha.

The first great event of the Games is when the Olympic torch is lit in Olympia, Greece, several months before the Games start. **3. \_\_\_\_** It arrives during the opening ceremony. The ceremony is an important part of the Olympics. First, in the Parade of Nations, athletes march into the stadium, country by country. **4. \_\_\_\_** The host team is always at the back. Next there are speeches and then the Olympic anthem is played. After that the Olympic flag is carried into the stadium, the torch is brought and the Olympic cauldron is lit. **5. \_\_\_\_** This is to show that the Olympic Games are always held in peace. Then, after an athlete and a judge have promised to compete and judge fairly, the host country's national anthem is played. At the end of the ceremony there is a wonderful show with music and dancing.

For the next sixteen days, the best sportspeople in the world compete with each other. There are always surprises, disappointments and great moments. New records are set. Hundreds of medals are awarded and many people become famous.

At the closing ceremony, the athletes enter the stadium once more, this time not in their national teams but all together. **6. \_\_\_\_** The next host nation then introduces itself with artistic displays. The fire in the cauldron is put out and the Games have finished.
