World Laughter Day

For over 25 years, on the first Sunday in May, thousands of people from more than 120 countries get together and celebrate World Laughter Day. And what do they do? They laugh and laugh ... and laugh! People from 'laughter clubs' in cities and towns 38. _____ the planet invite their friends and family members to join them, usually in public spaces. One very large 'laughter event' took place in the year 2000, when 10,000 people of different ages and backgrounds 39. _____ in the Town Hall Square of Copenhagen – to laugh!

The very first World Laughter Day took place in 1998 in a park in 40. _____ city of Mumbai, India. It was organised by Dr Madan Kataria, the person who also founded Laughter Yoga. Laughter Yoga is not about thinking of something funny, but it is based on a series of easy-to-do exercises that include the act of laughter. Like other types of yoga, it 41. _____ our physical and mental well-being. One fascinating point that Dr Kataria makes is that for the body, there is no difference between 'pretend' or 'fake' laughter and real laughter. 42. _____ the laughter is deep or hard, it doesn't matter. After regularly attending a 'laughter gym', you begin to feel the physical and emotional benefits.

Deep laughter causes our muscles to relax, which helps to cope with stress. During laughter our body releases chemicals that are associated with positive events and emotions. Stranger Things Season 5

It's official: Season 5 of *Stranger Things* will be its last. Back in February 2022, 46. _____ in an open letter shared with fans alongside season 4's official poster.

"Seven years ago, we planned out the complete story arc for *Stranger Things*," the duo wrote in their letter. "At the time, 47. _____ It proved too large to tell in four, but — as you'll soon see for yourselves — we are now hurtling toward our finale. Season 4 will be the penultimate season; season 5 will be the last."

"With nine scripts, over eight hundred pages, almost two years of filming, 48. _____, *Stranger Things* 4 was the most challenging season yet, but also the most rewarding one" the Duffer Brothers shared, calling the fourth season "the beginning of the end." The duo also shared that the decision to split the season in two parts was due to its "unprecedented length" and 49. _____.

The Duffer Brothers have served as the series creators and showrunners since *Stranger Things* premiered on Netflix back in 2016. Now, with a two-volume season 4 in the rearview, there's only one chapter left to focus on for our favorite group of Hawkins kids.

The Duffer Brothers also hinted that 50. _____. "There are still many more exciting stories to tell within the world of *Stranger Things*; new mysteries, new adventures, new unexpected heroes."
